PRESENTATION

Developments in technology have recently transformed our way of working. In-depth knowledge of computer science therefore becomes essential in research and graduates in the arts and humanities often find themselves faced with using computer tools in their field of research and in workplace

With this in mind, the undergraduate degree in digital humanities aims to **train in 3 years students in new professions**, so that they can develop digital skills, and thus add a **digital dimension** to their area of expertise; allowing them to **open up to other disciplines**, even to a larger community.

In short, undergraduate degree in Digital Humanities aims to train future executives who wish to specialise in both **humanities and computer science studies**.

It is a **multidisciplinary programme**, and students will carry out studies in all the disciplines studied - languages, history, literature, computer science, etc.

SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- **Computing and digital skills:** basic programming, database, data visualisation, basic skills, which would be the mastery of web technologies, etc.
- **Literary and cultural skills:** history, analysis, etc.
- **Archival:** cultural heritage, cultural tourism, etc.
- **Cross-disciplinary skills:** communication, etc.

SPECIFICITIES

- **Multidisciplinary** : open to a **wide range of study's fields** (humanities, arts, literature, economics, management, etc.) économie, gestion...etc.)
- **Blended course** (both face-to-face and online)

- Dissertation and Industrial attachment
- Bilingual course (**English/French**)

OBJECTIVES

- **Professional** : The Bachelor's degree in Digital Humanities will lead students on a multi-sector professional path ranging from **research** to **publishing, advertising, communication, public relations, journalism** (data journalist, etc.), as well as **heritage conservation institutions** (collection, cataloguing, visibilization, virtual museum, etc.). But also, the students can aim at **teaching** (transmission of a citizen conscience, training in media, images and information and communication technologies). The degree also provides you with access to **new jobs in digital creation** within large groups and SMEs with a multimedia division, communication agencies, advertising or studios positioned on online media, etc. Finally, the bachelor's degree opens to **jobs in the area of document management**, databases, archives, cartographies, digital communication, cultural activities, administrative and support services activities, administrative services..
- **Research** : The scientific objectives are to train specialists in understanding, modeling, designing and optimizing oral transcriptions with the support of ICT tools and applying and implementing different skills and computer knowledge (programming, algorithms, computer networks and databases) to the fields of humanities and social sciences.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND FURTHER STUDIES

The Udm's CDH welcomes HSC holders from various fields (literature, management, economics, science, etc.) to enrol in the first year of the BA (Hons) in Digital Humanities.

Year 1: Cambridge Higher School Certificate or any equivalent validated title. An Application form must be completed. A very good command of English and French is required.

The CDH reserves the right to ask for language proficiency tests.

Further studies : After their three-year BA, students can pursue a Master's degree in Digital Humanities.
