

VISA REQUIREMENTS- INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS not residing in Mauritius at time of application

- 1. All <u>copies</u> should be sent by e-mail on <u>admission-international@udm.ac.mu</u>
- 2. All **original** documents should be sent by post on the following address:

The Head of International Affairs, Student Welfare and Support Université des Mascareignes Avenue de La Concorde Camp Levieux Rose Hill Mauritius

- 3. <u>Students are strongly advised</u> to first <u>send copies of all documents via email</u> to the admission office on <u>admission-international@udm.ac.mu</u> and await for confirmation before sending the original ones through post.
- 4. Processing of visa will start once the university receives all original and copies of documents as requested above.

Students details

- 7 Application form to enter Mauritius-duly filled-in and signed by student (<u>original to</u> be sent by post)
- 2. 6 passport-sized photos (size 4.5 cm X 5.5 cm) (original to be sent by post)
- 3. **Copy**-Birth certificate (to be sent by e-mail)
- 4. Copy-Bio data-Passport-valid beyond duration of course (to be sent by e-mail)
- 5. "Original acceptance letter -written/signed confirmation from student that course offered has been accepted. (original to be sent by post)

University details

1. Copy of admission letter received from the University (to be sent by e-mail)

<u>Documentary evidence of availability of funds/financial capacity from Guardian/parents</u>

- Sponsorship letter from guardian/parent/sponsor certifying responsibility for financial support to pay tuition fees and cost of living of student (original to be sent by post) (*see sponsorship letter template*)
- 2. Copy of passport/Identity Card of Guardian/parent/sponsor
- 3. Original Bank statements of guardian/parent-last <u>6 months</u> as from date documents to require entry permit are submitted by students.



Note:

The amount should be indicated in USD/EURO/Mauritian Rupee. The bank statement should bear the original signature and original seal of the bank, failing which application for visa will not be processed. For courses with a duration of <u>3 years</u>, the bank statement should have a minimum balance of

- $(i) \ Rs\ 200\ 000\ (Mauritian\ rupees)\ for\ students\ whose\ yearly\ tuition\ fees\ are\ Rs\ 45\ 000\ (SADC\ fees)$
- (ii) Rs 300 000 (Mauritian rupees) for students whose yearly tuition fees are Rs 80 000 (NON SADC fees)

Accommodation details

- Letter <u>signed</u> by Landlord (owner of house) (<u>original to be sent by post</u>) (¹⁰see accommodation letter template)
- 2. **Copy** of Landlord's National Identity Card (to be sent by e-mail)
- Copy of recent proof of Address-Central Water Authority(CWA)/Central Electricity Board(CEB)/Telecom bill (not more than 3 months) (to be sent by e-mail)

Original medical tests certificates (original to be sent by post)

- 1. HIV
- 2. Hepatitis B
- 3. Chest X-ray (to send only the report and not the large film/radiograph)
- 4. A medical report certifying that student Is not suffering from any contagious disease and is medically fit to travel and study in Mauritius
- Copy of vaccination card against covid-19 (where the different doses are specified)

Important note:

- Due to sanitary protocols, other documents may be required for grant of the student visa.
- For access to the university, students should be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 or otherwise be in possession of a negative RT-PCR test result dating back to no more than 7 days from the date or a valid certificate of exemption.
