

MSc Industrial Internet of Things (IIoT)

Information to Enterprises/ Applicants

1. Only employees of enterprises contributing to training levy can apply for this course;
2. Present, past GTES trainees and GTES dropouts who participated in Masters course are not eligible;
3. Those who have already benefited or dropped out from a fully-funded Masters course under Skills Development Programme for AI are not eligible;
4. Holders of occupation permits and work permits are not eligible;
5. Participating enterprises should be employing at least 5 full-time employees;
6. The applicant needs to demonstrate that his/her current employer has a current/prospective project on IIoT;
7. This application form should be filled jointly and co-signed by enterprise and applicant.
8. Release of participants will be required to attend afternoon classes twice a week, three full-day workshops during the programme, and additional lectures conducted by international professors;
9. Interviews of all selected applicants will be carried out by a panel constituting of members from HRDC, UDM, and others; and
10. Candidates will have to pay only a non-refundable application fee (Rs. 700) for the application to be considered.

Additional information for admission of students

- Acceptable qualifications for entry at any level must be recognised by relevant bodies (Mauritius Qualifications Authority, Government Examination Boards, Regulatory bodies such as HEC etc.)
- CVs and motivation letter must be submitted by all applicants
- Letter of reference is required from current employer

Alternative mode of student recruitment may be considered (as per UDM policy)

The following is put in place to cater for students with alternative qualifications:

- A Recruitment Committee, comprising of the Dean, HODs, and Program Coordinator will look into each student application individually
- For students who do not have traditional academic qualifications, equivalence is sought from either HEC/ MQA where necessary
- Interviews are conducted for mature students with a minimum of industry experience

- The University uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), which allows students to transfer their credits from other universities to continue their courses at the Udm
