### **Entry requirements**

MPhil	We require applicants to hold at least an Upper Second class Honours degree (or overseas equivalent) in a related	FT-2 years
	subject area for entry.	PT- 3 years
MPhil/PhD	We require applicants to hold at least an Upper Second	FT – 3 years
	class Honours degree (or overseas equivalent) in a related subject area for entry.	PT – 5 years
PhD	We require applicants to hold an MPhil or a Master's degree (or overseas equivalent) in a related subject area for entry.	FT- 3 years

#### Mode of application:

Candidates should submit

- 1. Filled application form
- 2. Letter of motivation
- 3. Research proposal
- 4. Details of Director of Studies (main supervisor) (eligibility criteria is on application form)
- 5. Copy of educational certificates. Candidates holding foreign qualifications are advised to pursue recognition and equivalence of their credentials from the Higher Education Commission. Visit

- 6. Copy of National Identity Card/Passport
- 7. Proof of payment for application fee (MRU 700 for Maurtian applicants and 25 USD for international applicants excluding bank charges)
