



Scholarship Announcement and Conditions

The **Université des Mascareignes (UdM)** is pleased to offer **three (3) scholarships** to eligible candidates from the departments of the **Faculty of Sustainable Development and Engineering** who have successfully completed the **BSc (Hons) Full-Time programme (Academic Year 2023-2026)** and are seeking to integrate into the **School of Engineers at ENSIL-ENSCI of Université de Limoges** for a three-year engineering programme.

Interested graduates who have successfully completed the **BSc (Hons) Full-Time programme (Academic Year 2023-2026)** and achieved an **overall average (*moyenne pondérée*) of 13/20** in **Semesters 5 & 6** are invited to submit a **motivation letter outlining**, in general terms:

- their reasons for wishing to pursue further studies at the Université de Limoges;
- their specific interest in the proposed programme/field of study;
- how the proposed programme aligns with their academic background and long-term career aspirations;
- how the knowledge, skills and experience gained will contribute to their professional development and, in particular, their contribution upon their return to Mauritius; and
- any other relevant academic, professional or personal considerations supporting their candidature.

The motivation letter should present **clear, well-structured arguments**, demonstrate a sound, well-researched understanding of the chosen programme or field of study, and establish a clear link between the candidate's previous studies, the proposed programme, and their future academic and professional ambitions.

Candidates whose motivation letters demonstrate strong potential and clear alignment with the objectives of the scholarship will be **shortlisted and invited to an interview** before the final selection is made.

Conditions Applicable to Selected Candidates

Successful candidates will be required to comply with the following conditions:

- **Scholarship Bond:** Each selected recipient shall sign a formal bond with the Université des Mascareignes, the value of which shall reflect the total quantum of the scholarship awarded. The bond will set out the student's obligations in relation to the scholarship and their conduct during the period of study.

- **Progress Reports:** Duly completed and signed progress reports, endorsed by both the recipient and the relevant supervising authority at the Université de Limoges, shall be submitted to the UDM **no later than two working days before the first day of each semester**. Continued satisfactory academic progress will be a condition for the continued disbursement of scholarship funds.
- **Disbursement of Funds:** Scholarship funds for the following academic year will be disbursed subject to the submission and satisfactory assessment of the required academic progress documentation and transcript. **Where a recipient is required to repeat an academic year, the scholarship will be suspended for that year and may resume in the subsequent year, subject to satisfactory academic progression and the applicable scholarship conditions.**
- **Final Report:** Upon completion of the programme, each scholarship recipient shall submit a final report, duly signed by him/her, the **Director of the Engineering School (or equivalent authority)** and the **President of the Université de Limoges**. The report will be submitted to UDM Management for onward submission to the **Board of Governors**.
- **Return and Knowledge Sharing:** Upon returning to Mauritius, each scholarship recipient will be required to deliver a presentation to the **academic and student communities of the Université des Mascareignes**, sharing the knowledge, experience, and skills acquired during their studies at the Université de Limoges.

The scholarship is intended not only to support the academic development of the selected students but also to ensure that the knowledge and expertise acquired through that opportunity are **transferred back to the students of the Université des Mascareignes, contribute to the wider academic community, and support the development of Mauritius.**
